



Pinnacle Tent Liner

Installation Instructions

Pre-conditioning for New Liners:

Important: Always wash your hands before handling the fabric. We recommend that new liners be removed from plastic shipping wrap and be pre-conditioned for the first installation. Thoroughly fluff and shake out the liner to begin removing factory folds. Stuff the liner sections into their storage bags, as you would sheets into a laundry bag. If time allows, repeat process several more times, allowing the liner to rest for a day between 're-stuffing.' An alternate process is to pre-wash the liner to remove the sizing in the fabric and remove the creases. On the final crush, stuff the liner into the bag with the valance edges at the bottom of the bag and the vinyl pole hub at the top.

Installation Procedures for Pinnacle Liner:

Step 1. Start by applying the sling to center mast during installation of the tent. The pulley and ropes will pull up the liner around the center mast. If the sling is not attached during installation, we suggest clamping the sling to the center pole within 2 feet of the top, with a typical hose clamp.

Step 2. Once the sling, pulley, and rope are in place on the center mast, tent installation can resume. Once the tent is completely installed, tied, and staked down, it is ready for a liner.

Step 3. Install the bail ring around the center mast and connect to the pull rope. Tie off the rope at the eave to hold the bail ring 1-2 feet above cross cables.

Step 4. Pull out the two-piece tent liner. Using only one of the liner sections, secure the vinyl pole hub on the bail ring, pull eave webs out and affix liner straps to the eave of frame. Make sure the liner fits into corners, and be certain the hook and loop lines up in the center of each side of the tent.

Step 5. Install the second half in the same manner as in step 4. Join the two sections and close hook and loop. The liner should now fit the tent at the perimeter, but lay on the cross cables.

Step 6. If you are using a center mast drape lining, be ready to affix it to the bail ring at this time.

Step 7. Go to the rope at the eave, preferably at a corner; gently pull up the line until you achieve the desired height and look of the liner.



Note: Center mast drapes come in two types and have different installation methods.

- a. Gathered mast drapes must be installed ahead of time, or during installation of tent.
- b. Straight mast drapes can be secured to the bail ring hub and pulled up after the tent is standing.
